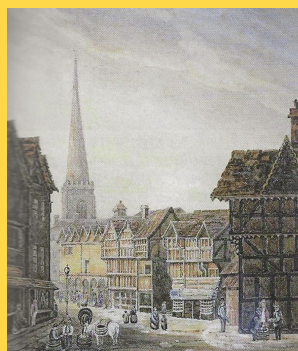

historic city from April to October, and pre-booked and
themed walks throughout the year.

We are a voluntary, non profit making organisation. Our
income is used for education and training, to promote
the Guild and to fund our insurance.

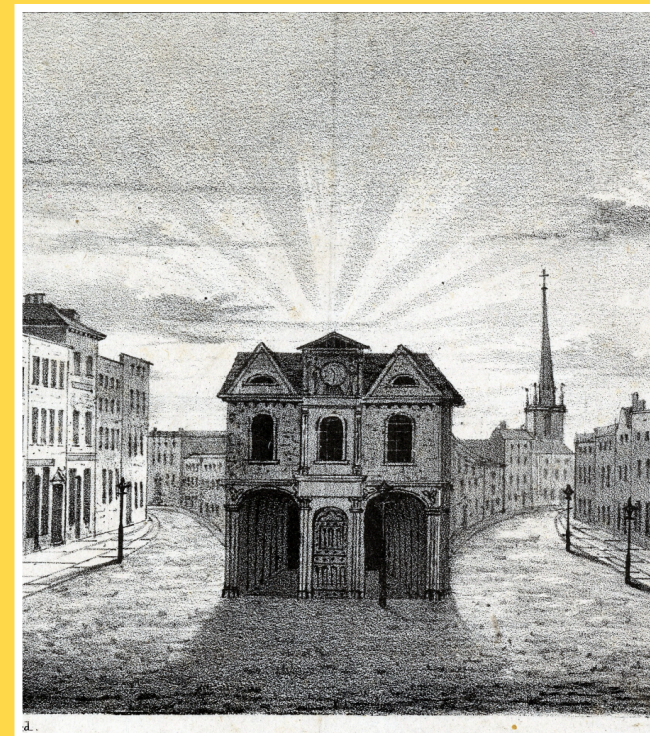
During the Autumn and Winter months members meet
for lectures and conviviality. We have an annual visit to
another town to learn from their guided walks, as well as
social activities for members and friends.

Those who intend to become guides will complete a
further four sessions and an assessment on essential facts
